

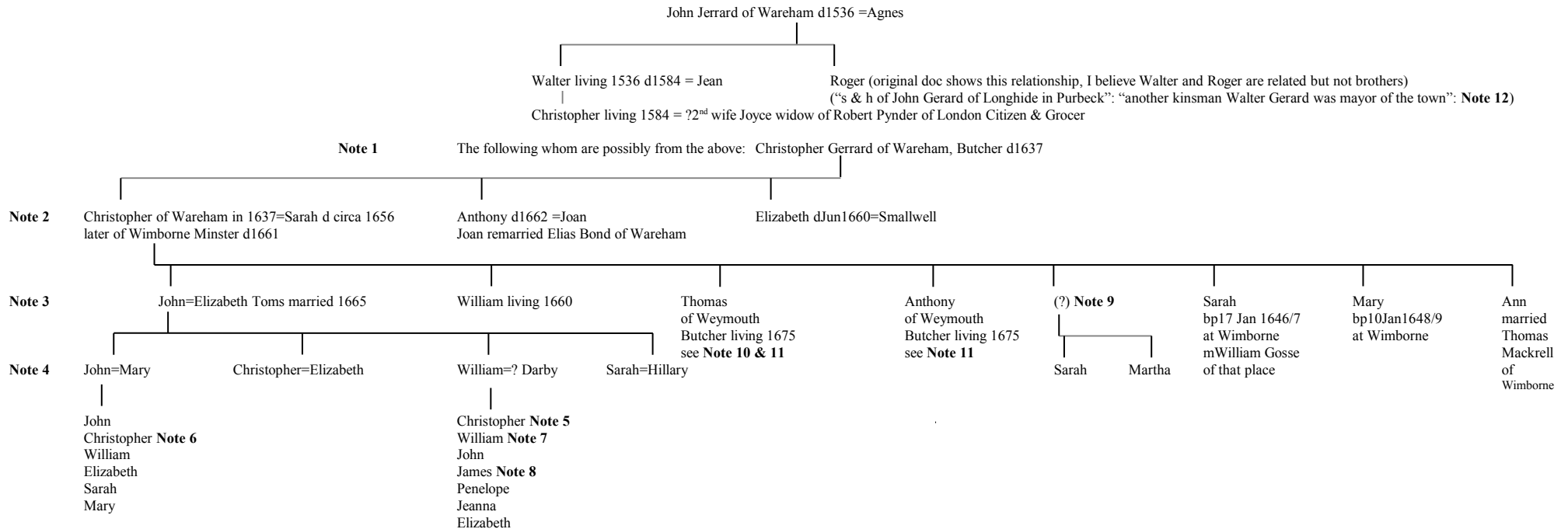
## JERRARD, Wareham and WimborneMinster

(date convention: day-month-year)

I use convention – b=birth, bp=baptised, m=married, d=death and/or buried, d.s.p.=died without children

This chart is transcribed from records that have been taken from a set of books on Jerrard (and various spelling) in the FH/GAR section of the Society of Genealogists Library, Donor REF Garrett, Esq., 27/7/1966.



**Note 1** – I have transcribed some written notes from the original chart to notes below. I have added, within the notes, information drawn from the Wimborne Minster parish records, which are very damaged.

**Note 2** – There is a 'Will' dated 1660 of which I do not have a copy. Wimborne Minster register shows Christopher dMay1661 also Sarah dMar1660/1, just two months previous to her husband and also a record of Widow Jerrard d1663. Widow Jerrard could be the widow of Ralphe d1662 (see Note 9).

**Note 3** – From original chart – John of Wimborne, Butcher (PCC Will 1719). From records I have found – Wimborne parish register record - John Jerrard (as written with J) married Elizabeth Tomes Apr1664/5, a copy of inventory for admin for John shows his trade as Butcher; Regarding Anthony of Weymouth, Butcher - Sarah Gerrard bp18Jul1663 daughter of Anthony, d1663; Martha Gerard daughter of Anthony bp20Nov1666; John Gerrard son of Anthony bpSep1673. Also a record for marriage of Mary Jerrard to Nicholas Reddam m18Jan1680 [I can not confirm this is the daughter of Christopher but it is likely].

**Note 4** – From original chart – John bp1666, deceased 1733, married Mary living 1733; Christopher bp25Apr1671 late of St Andrew Holborn London a d.s.p. 1724 (PCC Will), his wife Elizabeth (PCC Will 1735); William bp29Sept1673 at Wimborne later of Canford living 1716 but deceased 1732 married ??? Darby; Sarah married Hillary.

From records I have found, parish records for - John bp24Apr1666; Christopher bp25Apr1671; William bp29Sep1673; Sarah bpFeb1678, m25Sep1694 to Richard Hillary; Peter bp10Jan1679; Alexander bp01Jul1682; and Mary bp30Mar1685.

**Note 5** – From original chart – Christopher apprenticed to Tanner at Hingwood 1715 living 1732.

**Note 6** – From original chart – Christopher of St Luke Old Street Silversmith dsp 1772 (PCC WILL).

**Note 7** – From original chart – William apprenticed to a Woolcomber(trade) at Wimborne1714 living 1732.

**Note 8** – From original chart – James apprenticed to a Joiner at Poole 1723 living 1732.

**Note 9** – The original chart had a question mark (?) indicating another child, name unknown, and showing daughters Sarah & Martha. I have found in the Wimborne Minster register records for Jasper b1648 son of Ralphe; Ralphe d1662. I suspect Ralphe is a son of Christopher d1637. The name of the question mark child remains unknown.

**Note 10** - This family continues to Ray Jerrard's London family of the 1800s.
