The birth records above do not show Charles son of Nicholas. References below will place Charles the sixth son of Nicholas and Elizabeth. The Visitation of London 1634 shows Charles as the sixth son and Anne as 2nd daughter yet we have a record of Anne death 1619. Most probably there was a second daughter named Anne.

Richard Jerard, fourth son of the said Nicholas. He was of St. John's College, Oxford, and subscribed 7 Dec 1650.
