

## **Alfred Clive Jerrard b1893d1981**

Alfred Clive was the son of James Cabell Jerrard. Clive's grandfather was James Thurgar Jerrard. Clive's uncles were Alfred Cabell Jerrard & Robert Cabell Jerrard. Clive's grand uncle was Henry Charles Jerrard.

There is no definitive information as to when Clive arrived in Australia. His father was married in British Columbia, Canada in 1908. There is a record of A Jerrard, General Servant, on the ship Makura from Vancouver BC, Canada arriving in Sydney on 29 Dec 1909. His age is 16 and birth in London. Name spelt correctly, age is correct for birth date and place of birth correct. Is it him?

Of note is that the previous voyage of the Makura from Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada a J.C. Jerrard was a crew member. Since both father & son end up in Australia and both were in Vancouver I believe both of these records can be attributed to them. What adds to this conclusion is that an Army record, second war, for Alfred Clive shows his birth place as Vancouver (although not correct), he was born in England, to me it indicates he was in Vancouver.

Some early Australian records for Alfred Clive record his name as A. Jerrard or Alfred Jerrard and not Alfred Clive Jerrard. The best example is his Australian military record for the first war. This record definitively places him & his father in Australian in 1916.

Two Electoral roll records for 1914 & 1915 show an Alfred C Jerrard in Randwick, could be Alfred Cabell Jerrard or Alfred Clive Jerrard?

It seems that Clive had one wife, Myra James, married 8 Apr 1938, St Joseph's Church, Benella and one son Michael James Jerrard who was born around that time period.

The wedding announcement shows that both Alfred Clive's parents are dead. There is a death record for James Cabell Jerrard 1929 and a cemetery record, Macquire Cemetery, shows death of 16 Apr 1929 and burial C of E A7, Grave 0004. There is no info to indicate who the wife was. We do know that James's Vancouver wife (Ada Mary Isabel Jehen) was in England in 1911 (Census) and that she died in 1974 at the age of 104 (the record shows her name as Jerrard). Did James have another wife in Australia?

Alfred Clive enlisted and served in the Army in the second war, home duties. As indicated above that record shows his birth in Vancouver.

The 1963 Voting record shows Myra and Michael living with Clive. The 1980 voter record shows Clive, Myra & Michael living at 55 Roberts Ave, Box Hill South, Victoria, Chisholm, Australia.

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It seems that Clive had one wife, Myra James, married 8 Apr 1938, St Joseph's Church, Benella and one son Michael James Jerrard who was born 27 Jul 1940 and died 14 Apr 2004.

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Clive died 1981 at Surrey Hills, Victoria, Australia.
