PREFACE

A sketch pedigree of the London family is shown in Frederick Bartholomew Joseph Jerrard's 1912 book as Appendix IV pages 57 and 58¹ and copied as appendix 1 to this booklet. Frederick Bartholomew J. Jerrard (F.B.J.) was not able to connect the Modern London family to the Sampford Orcas family. The accounts from family members of the day, as noted in his book on page 57, the London Jerrards bear a striking physical resemblance to the Jerrard's of Chideock.

I saw a copy of a letter from Mr. Raymond (Ray) Edmund Jerrard of Taree, New South Wales, Australia (Ray now lives in Cooranbong, Australia). In that letter Ray mentioned a Mrs. Grossmith, a cousin of Ray's father, daughter of Charles Henry Dinn Jerrard and niece to Edmund Paul Dinn Jerrard. She did some research in the mid 1970's. In her letter to Ray Jerrard she plainly indicated that she was convinced of the direct relationship with the Sandford Orcas family. She did not explain her proof for that deduction. I have been in contact with Ray and the following chapter includes not only my collection of information but also that information which Ray has provided to me.

The following adds to the London Jerrard information of F.B.Js. book. My information comes from many original sources obtained in England at the various Archive repositories, documents on microfiche at the Society of Genealogists in London, England, digitized sources now available through Ancestry.com on the internet and other internet sources. It is interesting to note that some of the microfiche documents available at the Society Of Genealogists where provided by Mrs. Grossmith.

I have attached an updated “page 58” as produced by Ray Jerrard and revised by myself².

CHAPTER 1

CHRISTOPHER JERRARD

F.B.J. wrote, on page 58, that "There was a Christopher Jerrard at Wareham, in Dorchester, in 1637"³. The 1623 Visitation of Somerset shows “Nicholas Jerard of Londone mercator”. The 1634 Visitation of London shows the family of Nicholas Jerard of London, Merchant Taylor. The parish records for St. Augustine Watling Street (St. Austin's by St Paul's Gate or just St. Austins) having a family for Nicholas of 5 daughters and 7 sons. They are: Elizabeth, Anne (died young), John, Nicholas, Robert, Richard, Mary, Thomas, Sarah, George, Stephan and Katherine. Charles who is mentioned in the Merchant Taylors roll of honour and shown on the 1634 Visitation is not mentioned in any other records regarding birth, marriage nor death. It should be noted that Richard was the 3rd child named Richard of this family⁴. The first 2 children named Richard having died. The surviving Richard is listed in the Merchant Taylors' School Register Roll of Honour as having attended there 1638 to 1640 and attending St John's College Oxford 1650. Thomas is listed in the Merchant Taylors' School Register Roll of Honour attending there 1645-48. He received his M.A. from Jesus College (Oxford?) in 1654 and was perhaps Headmaster of Reading Grade School in 1655.

The great fire of London occurred in 1666 burning through the entire area that this family had been resident and worked in.

Does Christopher, shown as the beginning of the 1800's Jerrard line, descend from Nicholas's family of the 1600's who are proven to decent from the Sampford Orcas family? The answer is No.

I can prove descent from a Thomas & Grace of Weymouth to Christopher & Sarah to Thomas & Susannah (1st wife) & Jane Fore (2nd wife) to Paul b1754 & Elizabeth Frankland. Prior to that, I can prove descent of Thomas, husband of Grace, from Wareham in the late 1500s⁵.

THOMAS JERRARD

The book by F.B.J. shows Thomas descent from Christopher (mentioned above). I now refer you to my documents [WykeRegis.pdf]⁶, [WykeRegisFamily.pdf]⁷, [JerrardWarehamAndWimborneMinster.pdf]⁸ and [JerrardWarehamAndWimborneMinsterFamily.pdf]⁹ which describe the descent as now known¹⁰.

Those documents show that Paul Jerrard was the son of Thomas Jerrard. That Paul apprenticed as a Tallow Chandler to his father Thomas. That Thomas left to Paul the implements of his trade. That Rebecca was a sister of Paul.

PAUL JERRARD

Paul was born on 17 Apr 1754 in Wyke Regis¹¹, “son of Thomas Jerrard & Jane his wife of Weymouth.” There are several Land Tax documents with him listed on them the last, that I have, being for Weymouth 1789. I, also, have a copy of an Indenture brought 14 Nov 1770 showing Tho Jerrard of Weymouth Tallow Chandler and Paul Jerrard apprentice and a copy of a transcription from 1805-1807 Holden's Triennial Directory Vols 1 and 2, publication year 1805 that shows Paul Jerrard, 46 King St, Soho, Tallow Chandler. Paul's first child, Phebe, was born in King Street, St Ann Parish; a witness was Rebeckah Jerrard.

Paul married Elizabeth Frankland in 1802¹² in St Ann Parish in London We do have the marriage record for his son's second marriage which states that Paul's trade is a Tallow Chandler¹³. We also have his son's third marriage record (1864) which shows Paul as deceased¹⁴ and his trade as a Leghorn bleacher and presser. [Leghorn: an Italian type of straw used in hat-making]. It would appear that Paul's trade changed at some point.

Paul and Elizabeth had 4 children: (1)Phebe b09Dec1804, King Street, St. Ann's Westminster, witness-Rebeckah Jerrard, Phebe married Isaac Garnsey¹⁵, she died in 1871; (2)Elizabeth b09Mar1808 Weedon Northampton¹⁶, she remained unmarried and died in 1880; **(3)Paul Jerrard, Gentleman** b22Oct1810 Weedon Beek, Northampton, he married Emily Jamima Spear Morgan¹⁷, he died in 1888 and (4)James¹⁸ b30May1812 Weedon Beek Northampton, he married Magdalana Bridel¹⁹, he seems to have died sometime after 1854 and before the 1861 census. (Died 1825 buried Gibraltar Burial Ground, Bethnal-Green Revised 2018)

(3) PAUL JERRARD, GENTLEMAN

b22Oct1810, d18Mar1888

The first son of Paul Jerrard and Elizabeth Frankland married his first wife Emily Jamima Spear Morgan a spinster. She was **not** the wife of infamous Captain Henry Morgan of Wales as indicated by F.B.J. Jerrard. Paul & Jamima were married in m18Jun1833²⁰ and she died in d31Mar1841²¹.

Paul had 6 sons: **(1)Paul who married Harriet Alban Dinn** see chapter 2, Paul is referred to as “The Younger”; (2)James Thurgar who married Ellen Cabell; (3)Henry Charles who married Rachell Rowell at Ealing, Christ Church; (4)Edwin who remained unmarried and died in 1874; (5)John who married Mary Hurst Daniell; (6)Reuben for whom there is no information available. It seems that Paul & Elizabeth had no daughters.

Paul, a widower, married his second wife Elizabeth Baldock on m21Jun1842²². There are no recorded children of this marriage. James Spear is listed as Elizabeth's father and she is shown as a widow. The 1851 Census for St Botolph Bishopsgate at 11 Primrose St. indicates the head of the family as Elizabeth Spear age 84 born Middlesex, Shadwell. Shown as her Daughter is Elizabeth Jerrard age 39 and her son in law Paul Jerrard age 40²³.

Paul married his third wife Hannah Freeman m16Nov1864. The marriage certificate²⁴ shows that they were married in the parish church of St Giles, Cripplegate, London both being from

Cripplegate and Hannah being of full age, a spinster and daughter of Richard Freeman a deceased farmer. There are no recorded children from this marriage²⁵.

It is clear from an advertisement²⁶ placed in "An Empire's Millennium" written by J. Thurgar Jerrard in 1877 that Paul's place of business was located at 170 Fleet Street. In 1881 Paul was a Lithographer, Engraver Printer located at 206 Fleet St.

Paul died d18Mar1888 at the age of 77 and was buried in Norwood Cemetery²⁷. Read the transcribed copy of his will for details²⁸.

Revision 2018 – Elizabeth Baldock was born Elizabeth Spear she 1st married James Morgan. They had a girl Emily Jamima Spear Morgan. Elizabeth then Married Samuel Baldock and then married Paul Jerrard her son-in-law.

CHAPTER 2

This chapter traces the line from Paul Jerrard (The Younger) & Harriet Alban Dinn through Edmund Paul Dinn Jerrard to Raymond Edmund Jerrard of Australia (names are in bold to better identify them for the line of descent).

Paul's brothers are mentioned in Chapter 3.

(1) PAUL JERRARD, THE YOUNGER²⁹

b08May1834³⁰, d.1923

Paul married Harriett Alban Dinn, daughter of Thomas Dinn, on m24Aug1858³¹. Paul is referred to as "The Younger" in the marriage record. It seems he was a photographer in 1867 and a professor of Music in 1882. According to Patricia Perry³² he was Choirmaster at Bow Church. He produced or contributed to at least five books "The Book of Exotic Birds", "Flower Painting in Twelve Progressive Lessons", "Shakesperian Tableaux" (Selections of Shakespeare with highly coloured illustrations by Paul Jerrard)³³, "Items for The Drawing Room" and "The Floral Offering". The two books I viewed are approximately 8 inches by 11 inches in size containing very fine and richly coloured drawings. They would be similar to what we refer to as "coffee table books". The description of the one book was "... consists of twelve highly colored birds for the 12 months of the year, Executed in a chaste and beautiful binding peculiar to itself ...". The address for Paul Jerrard at that time was 111 Fleet Street. The books were undated and in a very fragile state. The British Library has catalogued them circa 1852.

Paul and Harriett had 11 children: (1)Rose Harriett Dinn b1859; **(2)Edmund Paul Dinn** b29Jun1861³⁴; (3)Marian Eliza Dinn b1862; (4)Maude Flora Dinn b1864; (5)Ethel Maria Dinn b1865; (6)Charles Henry Dinn b1867; (7)Cyril Septimus Dinn b1879; (8)Clarence Peter Dinn b1871; (9)Edgar John Dinn b1871; (10)Cecilia Mildred Dinn b1875; (11)Christabel Eleanor Dinn b1877. The pedigree charts included with this booklet trace the rest of children of Paul (The Younger) & Harriet.

Patricia Perry tells a story that Paul married Harriett but also took as his mistress Harriett's sister. He had two children by his mistress, Herbert Jerrard-Dinn and Annie Jerrard-Dinn, Herbert being Patricia's grandfather. Herbert married a Harriet Mathews³⁵.

b29Jun1861, d24Apr1954.

Edmund was a salesman in England. He went to South Africa to fight in the Boer War and did not return to England. He married Olive Maude Healey b13Feb1865³⁶, daughter of Reuben Herbert Healey on m04Sep1887³⁷. They had 14 children³⁸;

I have been able to account for 11 children. Ray Jerrard tells me that family stories tell of some of the children dying young.

Edmund Paul Jerrard had more than 30 inventions to his credit. He worked in the Johannesburg area for Rand Mines and Crown Mines in the electrical department. Many of his inventions were used on the mines - electric bell without hammers, a ventilating system, turbines and centrifugal pumps, a more efficient system for steam locomotives use of heat from coal. He crusaded, at the end of 1800s, for alternating current generators in place of direct current generators and personally supervised their installation as no one else at the time knew how. In 1916 he patented a machine to show '3D' films but I. W. Schlesinger, thoroughly investigating it in England, rejected it as too costly. Other ideas he developed specifications for were a self-starter for motor cars in 1913 and a gearless car in 1916. He retired in 1931 at the age of 70³⁹.

CHAPTER 3

(2) James Thurgar Jerrard⁴⁰ b30Jan1836 d1894 & Ellen Cabell.

James Thurgar Jerrard is the second son of Paul Jerrard (b1810) and Emily Jamima Spear. James Thurgar Jerrard married Ellen Cabell. He died d06Jun1893 buried at Kensall Green. He was an artist and writer. His fictional book titled and annotated as follows - "An Empire's Millennium, The vision of Dionysius Krak-Jor and The Apotheosis of Ton circa BC 120" exhumed by J Thurgar Jerrard (in verse and prose) - was printed by R. Meek and Co. in 1877. This book is in the archives of the British Library and was viewed by me on 23 November 1999. It is in a very fragile state being similar to our paperback books of today. It appears to have been damaged by fire but the entire text is intact.

(3) Henry Charles Jerrard⁴¹ b19Jan1837 d1887 & Rachel Rowell.

Henry Charles Jerrard is the third son of Paul Jerrard (b1810) and Emily Jamima Spear. There will be no 1881 English Census since the entire family immigrated to Australia in 1880 on board the “Ben Voirlich” an English registered ship. They arrived in Melbourne, Australia on 20 Aug 1880⁴².

The family comprised of Henry Charles, Rachel his wife, Violet Mary (civil birth registration shows Mary not “L”)(b1871); Harry Leslie (b1872); Emily Gertrude (b1873) and Edith Blanche (b1876).

Apparently Henry Charles dies in Australia in 1887, no confirming records at this time, and sometime before the 1891 English Census some of the family, except Harry Leslie, return to England. Emily Gertrude was married in 1906, in England, to Henry Charles Blake and her mother signs as a witness.

(4) Edwin⁴³ b07Oct1838 d1874 . Unmarried

Edwin Jerrard is the fourth son of Paul Jerrard (b1810) and Emily Jamima Spear. Census records shows Edwin with the family at age 2 (1841 census). The 1871 census shows him as age 32; unmarried; living St. Giles, Lambeth, Camberwell; born Hackney, Middlesex. Edwin is shown as Edward in the 1912 book, now clearly an incorrect entry. Civil registration death record index, Edwin Jerrard, Camberwell, Sep 1874, 1d 330, age 35. Norwood cemetery burial record for Edwin Jerrard, age 36, 27 Aug 1874 having lived at Windsor Road,

- 5) 1881 Census Chelsea, age 41. Printseller. [JohnJerrard(b1839)1881Census.pdf]
- 6) Other census records show him as a Dealer in Cardboard. He may have died in 1905. It seems he and his wife were living apart after 1871.

(6) Reuben – we have no information relating to Reuben. He may have been born in 1841 which is the same year that his mother died. There is no record of him in any of the census returns after this date. It is probable that he dies shortly after birth and his mothers death is related to this event.

SUMMARY

Paul the first son did not follow in the family business as he became a Professor of Music. The other sons all worked in the printing business in one capacity or another including some of their wives as witnessed on the different census returns. James Thurgar, it appears, becomes the guiding force of the business around or before the 1871 census time period. Also involved in the business was their father's brother James Jerrard and his wife Magdalana.

Their father Paul dies in 1888, James Thurgar in 1894, Henry Charles went to Australia in 1880 and dies in 1887, Edwin had already passed away in 1874 and John dies in and around 1905. James, their uncle, seems to have died in or around 1856. Phebe, their aunt, dies in 1874 and Elizabeth, their aunt, dies in 1880. Paul Jerrard (b.1834), the Professor of Music, survives them all and dies in or around 1923.
