

Robert Cabell Jerrard b1870d1918

He left England sometime around 1900 to 1907 and arrived in Australia. He married, in Australia, m1907 May Mabel Ambler. One child was born Phyllis Mabel Isabel Jerrard b1908d1982. He left behind 3 children in England. His one daughter, Dorothy Elsie Jerrard records on her marriage, m1919, that her father was deceased. She married Walter Hagan.

Dorothy's mother Elsie Maud Luetchford, in the 1911 English Census, indicates that she is married.

There is an Oct 1909 police record in Australia looking for Robert Cabell Jerrard for child desertion; possibly concerning his Australian daughter.

Around 1910 to 1915 Robert marries Emmie (Marie?) Hebel. There are two daughters attributed to this marriage. Birth dates have not been found or can be attributed by me at this time. A newspaper article(s) relating to Roberts death stated he was a loving father of Linda & Hazel and that he died 5 months after breaking his spine trying to board a tram. At the time of his death he was a billiard saloon keeper in Footscray, Melbourne Ports, Victoria, Australia.

In a 1914 Electoral Roll he was described as a Commercial Traveller and Emmie as House Duties.

A newspaper advertisement dated 27 Mar 1915 in a Sydney newspaper offers a reward for the whereabouts of Robert Cabell Jerrard formerly employed by Messrs Anthony Hordern's in Sydney. Further the ad states "Address, if alive, or information of death required".

Robert was buried in Coburg C of E Cemetery, Melbourne (suburb) 18 Feb 1918.

Emmie may have married Hector Charles Thomas Curtis in 1920.
